10 Encouraging Bible Verses on New Life

You could even look them up in your Bible and read the surrounding verses to get the full narrative and context.

1. Romans 6:4 (NIV) - “We were therefore buried with him through baptism into death in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, we too may live a new life.”

2. Isaiah 60:1 (ESV) - “Arise, shine, for your light has come, and the glory of the Lord has risen upon you.”

7. Acts 5:20 (NIV) - "Go, stand in the temple courts," he said, "and tell the people all about this new life."

8. 2 Corinthians 5:17 (NLT) - "This means that anyone who belongs to Christ has become a new person. The old life is gone; a new life has begun!"

9. Romans 7:6 (GW) - “But now we have died to those laws that bound us. God has broken their effect on us so that we are serving in a new spiritual way, not in an old way dictated by written words.”

10. Lamentations 3:22-23 (ESV) - “The steadfast love of the Lord never ceases; his mercies never come to an end; they are new every morning; great is your faithfulness.”
